

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the scala rider Q-solo *Bluetooth®* headset for motorcycle helmets. This manual will help you set up, configure and operate it.



CHARGING THE SCALA RIDER

Make sure that your scalarider is fully charged for at least 4 hours before initial use.

- Charging with a 5v wall charger is faster than charging with a computer USB port.
- RED LED ON Charging
- RED LED OFF Charging complete



The scala rider Q-solo is waterproof and dustproof. However, when in use, the USB silicone cover should be kept tightly closed to prevent moisture from entering the unit.

3.2 GENERAL FUNCTIONS

Power ON / OFF	Press (a) for 2 seconds ON: 3 BLUE flashes + Ascending tone OFF: 3 RED flashes + Descending tone	
Volume	Tap 🖸 or 🗢 to adjust and set volume of current audio source	
Mute	Tap ⊕ and ● simultaneously	
Battery Check	ttery Check In Standby, press	

3.3 VOX ACTIVATION

Your scalarider offers a voice operated feature for hands-free operation.

Answer a call	Speak any word loudly into the microphone
Reject a call	Remain silent for about 15 seconds

PAIRING AND USING A MOBILE PHONE, GPS DEVICE OR ANY MUSIC PLAYER

To connect your scalarider to a Bluetooth device you must first pair them. Once paired, they will automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range (10m / 33ft). Your scalarider has Bluetooth channel for connecting to a mobile phone, GPS device and a music player with A2DP.



Bluetooth Stereo music (A2DP), even if the phone has a music player function. Consult your mobile phone's User Manual for more information.

4.1 PAIRING BLUETOOTH

- 1. Make sure *Bluetooth* is enabled on your phone/GPS/MP3 player.
- 2. Check the scalarider is in Standby mode (single LED flashes every 3 seconds).
- 3. Press O for at least 5 seconds until the BLUE LED flashes once every 3 seconds
- 4. Search for Bluetooth devices on your phone/GPS/MP3 player by following the device's instructions
- 5. After a few seconds the device will list "scalarider **Q-solo**". Select it.
- 6. If prompted for a PIN or Passkey, enter 0000 (four zeros).
- 7. The device will confirm that pairing has succeeded and PURPLE will flash for 2 seconds
- 8. If pairing is not completed within 2 minutes, the scalarider will return to Standby mode.

4.2 MAKING AND RECEIVING PHONE CALLS

Answer a call	Tap 🔊 or say any word loudly to answer by VOX
Reject a call	Remain silent for 15 seconds, or press and hold 🛐 for 2 seconds
End a call	Tap 🗗
Voice Dial* (if supported by mobile phone)	Tap 🖸 and 🕐 simultaneously and follow the prompt from the mobile
Redial*	Press 🛐 and 🅑 for 2 seconds

4.3 LISTENING TO MUSIC VIA A2DP

NOTES:

Available only on compatible <i>Bluetooth</i> audio sources		
Play	In Standby, tap 🛐	
Pause/Stop	Press 🖸 for 2 seconds	
Next Track	With music ON, tap 🛐	
Previous Track*	With music ON, double tap 외	

*With some phones you may need to repeat this action

*This feature is not available during mobile calls

TROUBLESHOOTING

	Reboot	If your scala rider stops responding, reset it by turning it off and then on again (press () for 2 seconds).
5	Reset Pairing (Deletes paired device)	 In Standby, press for 5 secs until LED flashes RED/BLUE. Press for 2 seconds until LED flashes 5 times in PURPLE.
	Unresponsive Device	Please connect to your charging cable for 30 seconds to allow the device to reset.
